

# PENNSYLVANIA

## KNOW YOUR I.D. LAWS



Registered voters are NOT required to show photo I.D. to vote in the election on November 6, 2012, except first time Pennsylvania voters or voters voting at a new polling place. Voters will be asked for a photo I.D. but can still cast a regular (non-provisional) ballot without showing one.

### Acceptable Forms of **Photo** I.D. Include:

Government or state issued I.D. card

Pennsylvania driver's license or non-driver's license Photo I.D. Or I.D.s issued by PennDOT to comply with the blocked-for-November 6 voter I.D.

Valid U.S. Passport

U.S. military I.D.

Employee photo I.D. issued by federal, state, county, or municipal government

Student Photo I.D. from accredited state public or private school

### Acceptable Forms of **Non-photo** I.D. include: (must have name and address)

Voter Registration Card

Current Bank Statement, Recent  
Paycheck, Recent Government

Firearm Permit
