KNOW YOUR I.D. LAWS



Registered voters do NOT need I.D. to vote, except if they are voting for the first time in California and registered by mail, but did not provide an I.D. number with their application.

Acceptable Forms of I.D. include:

Driver's license or I.D. card of any state

U.S. Passport

Employee I.D. card, with voter's photo

Student I.D. card, with voter's photo

Credit or Debit card, with voter's photo

Other acceptable forms of I.D. include utility bills, bank statements, paychecks, and other government documents displaying the voter's name and address
