KNOW YOUR I.D. LAWS



Registered voters are required to show I.D. at the polling place before receiving a regular ballot. Voters can either show one photo I.D. or two non-photo I.D.s

Acceptable Forms of *Photo* I.D. Include:

Valid Arizona driver's license

Valid Arizona non-operating I.D. license

Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification

Valid U.S. federal, state, or local government issued identification

Acceptable Forms of *Non-photo* I.D. include (two needed):

Utility bill

Bank or credit union statement, dated within 90 days

Valid Arizona vehicle registration
