



All voters must present their voter registration certificate or an alternate form of identification. Voters without either can vote provisionally. Registered voters do NOT need I.D. to vote, except those voting for the first time in Texas and registered by mail, but did not provide an I.D. number with their application.

Acceptable Forms of I.D. include:

Voter registration certificate

Driver's license

A form of I.D. containing the person's photo
that establishes the person's identity

U.S. passport

Official mail addressed to the person,
by name, from a governmental entity

Certificate of U.S. citizenship
